## Paper 1

Essays are due at the beginning of lecture on <u>Monday, February 6<sup>th</sup></u>. The essay should be a minimum of 5 <u>full</u> pages in length (no more than 7) in the Humanities format\* and a counterargument is required.

Respond to one of the following prompts:

- 1. "Voltaire's *Candide* shows that Locke's account of a well-functioning government is completely unrealistic." Agree or disagree with this statement, giving reasons for your view.
- 2. "Voltaire's use of humor and rhetoric makes his critique of religion more persuasive than Hume's." Agree or disagree with this statement, giving reasons for your view.
- 3. What are the limitations of applying Enlightenment principles of scientific reasoning to social problems? Focus your essay on either Locke's view of government or Hume's view of religion.

Submit a paper copy of your essay to your TA in a plain manila folder with your name on it. Include all your previous Humanities papers in the folder. Before submitting a paper copy at lecture, you must submit an electronic copy to www.turnitin.com for text-similarity review. Information about that will be distributed and discussed in section by your TA.

**Late essays.** One day late is -10% (one letter grade). Two days late, -20% (two letter grades). Papers will not be accepted after two days.
